BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR - rouge 2020

Château Saint Julian stands in the heart of the Entre-Deux-Mers region, a step away from the Benedictine Abbey of La Sauve Majeure. With more structure than its younger brother Château Virecourt Conté, Château Saint Julian is consistently rich and enticing with its expressive black fruit aromas.

With its brilliant color, this wine reveals an expressive nose of blackberries and blackcurrants, enhanced by spicy notes. The black fruit aromas envelop the palate, the balance is delicate with firm, polished tannins that show depth and persistence on savory notes of wild berries. If you can wait you won't be disappointed. 59000 btl produced
