Tasting Notes



Very assertive notes of black fruit, ripe red fruit, but which do not tip over into a stewed, cooked fruit character. This is the hallmark of the vintage, this sunny yet fresh expression of fruit. Beautiful garnet color. On the nose, aromas of beautifully ripen black fruits and cocoa. Delicately balanced mouth whole in fruits with velvety tannins and always elegance.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot, 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
