

CHATEAU SAINT JULIAN

BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR - rouge 2022

Château Saint Julian stands in the heart of the Entre-Deux-Mers region, a step away from the Benedictine Abbey of La Sauve Majeure. With more structure than its younger brother Château Virecourt Conté, Château Saint Julian is consistently rich and enticing with its expressive black fruit aromas.

Tasting Notes



With its unusual climate and high temperatures, this vintage is characterized by freshness and candied fruit aromas. Saint Julian has a deep, brilliant, intense red color. On the nose, this wine reveals aromas of ripe black fruits such as black cherry, plum and blackcurrant, combined with spicy, woody notes. On the palate, this wine stands out for its powerful, elegant structure. Velvety tannins bring a sensation of softness, while aromatic persistence leaves a lasting imprint on your palate.
